



**Bruce R. Williams, DO, FACOFP**, practiced osteopathic family medicine for over 30 years in Eastern Jackson County, Missouri. He is currently the Associate Dean of Clinical Education at Kansas City University, College of Osteopathic Medicine.

Dr. Williams was elected President-Elect in 2021, following his appointment as Secretary/Treasurer of the ACOFP Board of Governors in March of 2019 and has chaired ACOFP's Task Force on Physician Wellness.
