






Initial Certification Grant



- Initial Certification covers up to \$1,400 in exam fees and travel for eligible residents.
 - Partial grants may be awarded.
- Residents must sit for both the AOBFP cognitive and practical exams.
 - Residents can choose between the AOBFP Early Entry Initial Certification (EEIC) pathway or the traditional initial certification pathway.

The Fall 2024/Spring 2025 Initial Certification Grant cycle will open in July 2024.
