

Willy Bustinza, DO

Dr. Willy Bustinza is a general surgeon who grew up in Peru where his parents funded a church and started a school for low-income children in Arequipa, the second largest city in Peru. After finishing his theological studies and becoming a youth pastor in Peru, Willy traveled to the United States to pursue a bachelor's degree in biomedical engineering at Oral Roberts University in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He subsequently earned his medical degree and completed his residency in general surgery at Oklahoma State

University.

Dr Bustinza and his wife Jessee (a pediatrician) served in the remote Copper Canyon of Mexico at Hospital Misión Tarahumara for three years where Willy worked as a general surgeon and was chief of medical staff. Hospital Misión Tarahumara is a mission hospital serving the native Tarahumara people, a community of approximately 100,000 who have limited access to healthcare. The Bustinzas are passionate about equipping national healthcare workers with the tools to impact their own communities.
